

K.A.R. 100-29-15. Professional liability insurance. (a) Each person licensed by the board or holding a compact privilege as a physical therapist shall, before rendering professional services within Kansas, submit to the board evidence that the person is maintaining the professional liability insurance coverage required by K.S.A. 65-2920 and amendments thereto, for which the limit of the insurer's liability shall be not less than \$100,000 per claim, subject to an annual aggregate of not less than \$300,000 for all claims made during the period of coverage.

(b) Each person licensed by the board or holding a compact privilege as a physical therapist and rendering professional services in Kansas shall submit, with the annual application for renewal of the license, evidence that the person is maintaining the professional liability insurance coverage specified in subsection (a).
