

K.A.R. 100-5-2. Special meetings. (a) ~~Special meetings may be called by~~ The president may call a special meeting at any time.

(b) The president shall call a special meeting ~~when a~~ upon written request ~~is made~~ by a quorum of the board ~~setting forth an~~ stating the agenda of business to be transacted at that meeting.

(c) The president shall give notice of the date, time, and place of any special meeting and an agenda of the business to be transacted at that meeting ~~shall be furnished~~ to each member of the board at least ~~five~~ two days ~~prior to~~ before the meeting.

(d) No business shall be transacted at a special meeting except as ~~set forth~~ specified in the agenda furnished pursuant to subsection (c) ~~above~~.

(e) The duties of the president may be performed by the vice-president if either of the following conditions is met:

(1) The president is absent or unable to perform that person's duties.
