**NOTICE OF HEARING ON PROPOSED AMENDED & REVOKED
ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS**

A public hearing will be conducted at 10:00 a.m. on July 22, 2008, at the office of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, 235 S. Topeka Boulevard, Topeka, Kansas to consider the adoption of two proposed amended rules and regulations, K.A.R. 100-69-1 and K.A.R.100-69-3, and one revoked rule and regulation K.A.R. 100-69-2, all pertaining to athletic trainers.

This 60-day notice of the public hearing shall constitute a public comment period for the purpose of receiving written public comments on the above referenced rules and regulations. All interested parties may submit comments prior to the hearing to the Board of Healing Arts, 235 S. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, KS 66603 or by e-mail to healingarts@ink.org. All interested parties will be given a reasonable opportunity to present their views, orally or in writing, concerning the adoption of the regulations during the hearing. In order to give all persons an opportunity to present their views, it may be necessary to request each participant to limit any oral presentations to five minutes.

Any individual with a disability may request accommodation in order to participate in the public hearing and may request the regulations being considered and the economic impact statements in an accessible format. Requests for accommodation should be made at least five working days in advance of the hearing by contacting Barbara Montgomery at (785) 296-8558 or at bmontgomery@ksbha.ks.gov.

Handicapped parking is located at the west end of the Hutton Building and the northwest entrance to the building is accessible.

The adoption of the two proposed amended rules and regulations and one revoked rule and regulation to be considered at the hearing and the respective economic impact are as follows:

K.A.R. 100-69-1. Approved education. This regulation establishes what proof of education will be required by applicants for licensure as athletic trainers.

K.A.R. 100-69-2. Clinical experience. This regulation specifies the number of hours and type of clinical experience required for licensure as an athletic trainer.

K.A.R. 100-69-3. Examination. This regulation designates the examinations required to be passed by all applicants to be licensed as an athletic trainer.

These regulations are not mandated by any federal law.

There is no foreseen cost to either the Board or the public to implement the regulations.

No other methods were considered.
